WASH Futures 2018 will be held at the award-winning Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre located in the inner-city riverside precinct of South Bank, the city's cultural and entertainment hub. South Bank is a prime location in walking distance to the CBD and the Cultural Centre Busway. The Trade Exhibition will be held on the Plaza Level (pictured below) where delegates will gather during breaks and before/after sessions & plenaries, providing maximum exposure. South Brisbane Train Station is located adjacent to the Centre on Grey Street and offers direct Air Train service to the domestic and international airports. The South Bank Precinct also features cultural, entertainment, dining and shopping attractions including more than 50 restaurants and cafes. There are also various hotels directly next, and adjacent, to the Centre.
