Intervention idea:

Insight 1

Basic latrines collapse frequently due to heavy rains and termites. Therefore, people need to be rebuilt frequently.

If they build a durable latrine, can forget about it and get on with their life.

Saves Time and Effort



Intervention idea:

Insight 2

Building a durable latrine enhances one's status in the community.

Namiruku - someone with a durable latrine is more aspirational – smart/wise, Educated, Richer, Intelligent, Openminded etc.'

Better Status





Insight 3

The cost and effort required to build a durable latrine is a barrier to its construction.

Knowledge about lowcost latrine that could be made by local material with personal labor was shared.




Latrines for coastal areas

- Condut a study on latrine construction in coastal areas;
- Government capacity building on BCD framework;
- Promote the Namiruku campaign nationally among Government stakeholders and other NGOs.





Challenges faced





Connect the Hub facilitators to local partners: Government, Creative team and implementation team

Avoid health messages on the intervention

Hard to monitor activities due to the distance between villages and households

Short period for the intervention to meet the goals

Availability of the household to build its latrine due to priority for harvest season in the farm
