

## Findings: building and maintaining political will

- Enablers
- Having a supportive national policy environment
- Engaging elected officials and technical staff
- Using data strategically
- Including sanitation standing agenda items in meetings
- Barriers
- Navigating political transitions/staff rotation





## Findings: use of data

- Using data strategically to:
- Foster political will
- Inform programme design
- Advocate for resources
- Using learning activities to:
- Support implementation quality
- Motivate staff and officials



## Findings: resourcing commitments

- Enablers
- Including specific sanitation lines in budgets
- Mandating spending on sanitation
- Using results based financing
- Developing policies allowing sanitation funds to be drawn from a range of budget lines/sources
- Barriers
- Funds committed but released late
- Funding redirected
- Not enough funding available





## Findings: Leaving no one behind

- A big gap!
- Ideas to test:
- Fostering LNOB champions
- Developing better methods to identify people who may be left behind
- Allocating budget for LNOB initiatives





#### **Conclusions and next steps**

- Lots of common themes emerged across countries and regions
- Participatory process had value as both a research and learning opportunity
- Practical ideas for supporting sub-national government leadership and prioritisation of sanitation, particularly around fostering political will
- More evidence on ways to improve outcomes for the most vulnerable is needed
- Planning to expand the research to Cambodia and Pakistan
