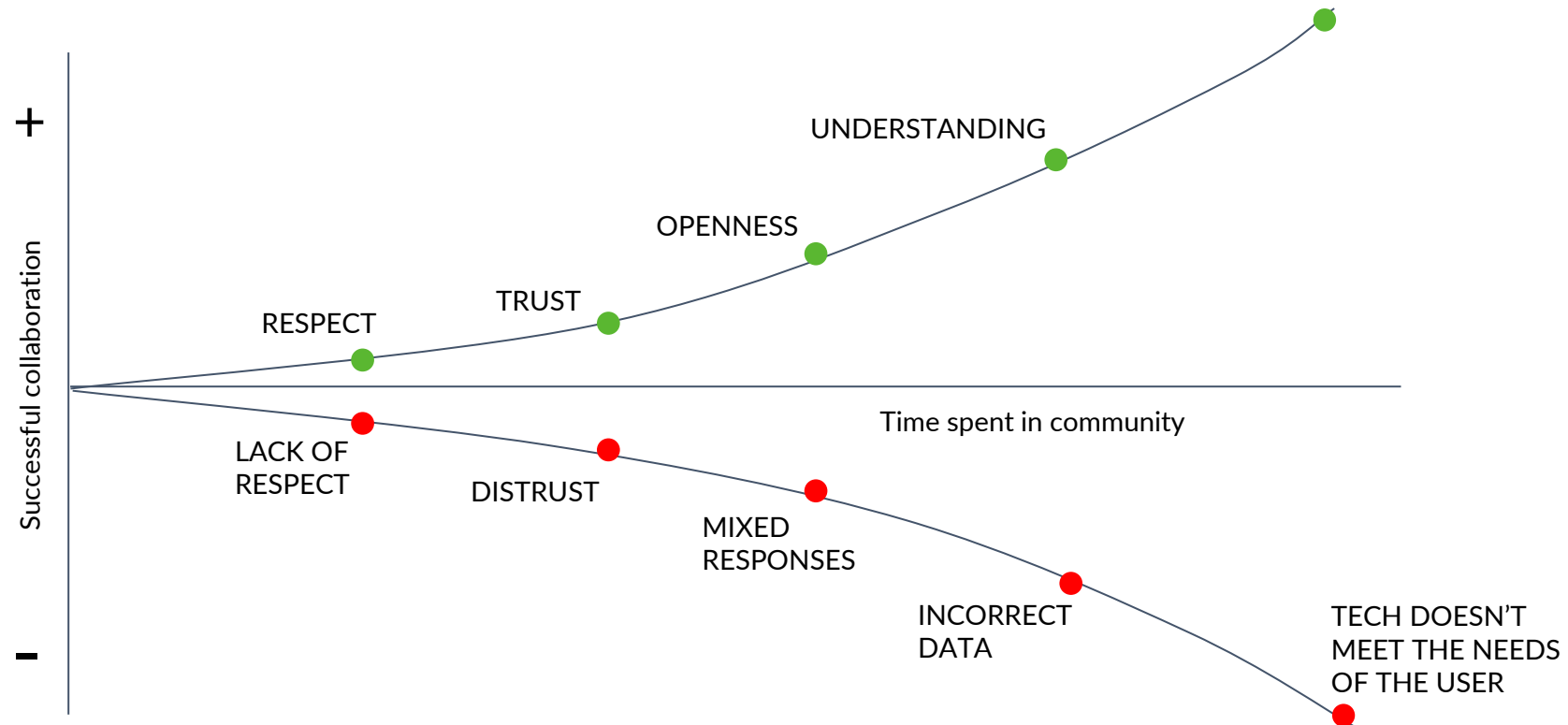

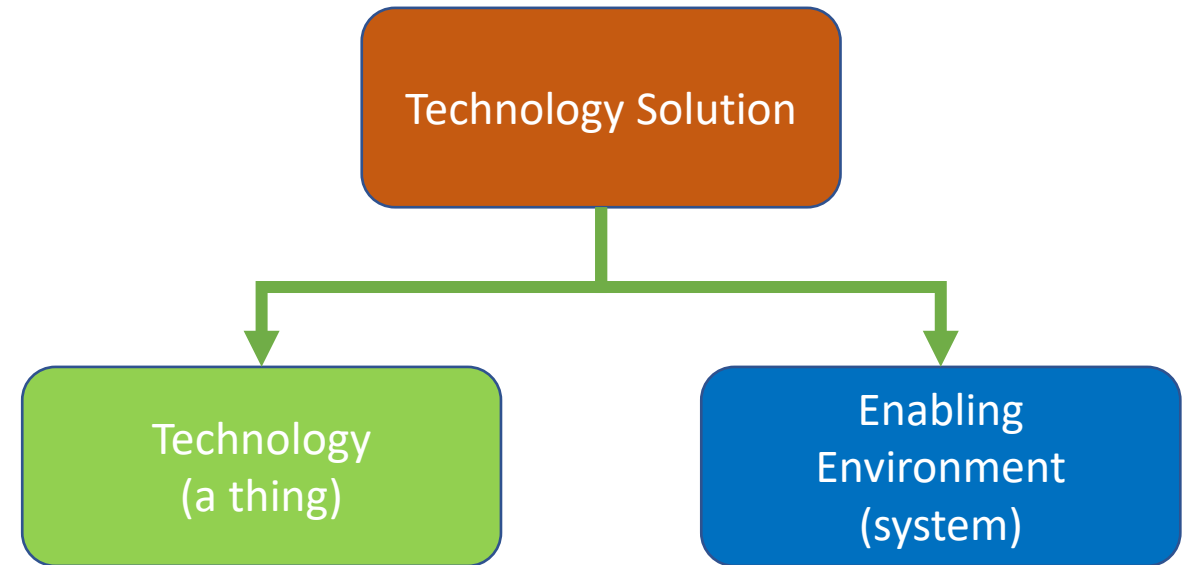


Relationships with the community



Technology Development Approach (TDA)

- EWB describes **Technology Solution** as the combination of a **Technology (a thing)** with an **Enabling Environment (a system)** to create and sustain positive impact
- **Technology:** ‘a specific product/technology that has been designed to address the needs and wants of the communities and wider stakeholders.
- **Enabling Environment:** ‘the system that supports the access to, awareness of and design, manufacture, implementation, operations and maintenance of a technology.

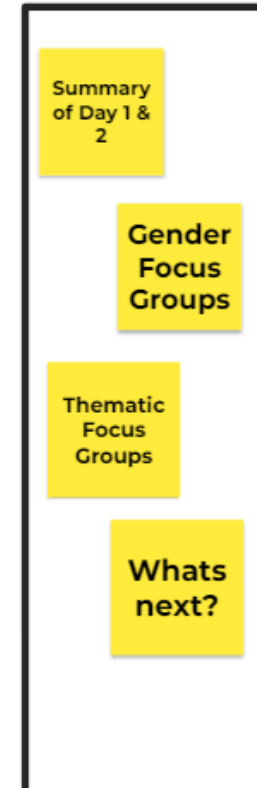
